

## Review Methodology/Collaboration Focused Grant Opportunities

A total of eight members attended the workshop including two Young Investigator awardees. After personal introductions once the concept of the working group was presented an enthusiastic and lively discussion ensued. There was strong support for the idea that ISCTM/members would offer meaningful contributions to appropriate RFPs for creating centers to solve methodological challenges. It was acknowledged that such RFPs would be uncommon and group members would need to be vigilant in identifying opportunities when they arise. One of the attendees NIH's SBIR grant program application came up as a potential to demonstrate the working group's ability to contribute to future RFPs. The group agreed that this could be attempted. The group also discussed ways to monitor for RFPs and maintain communication within the group and agreed to a quarterly phone call to do so.

- 3) Assist with responses to the SBIR grant application as needed
