Our Mission

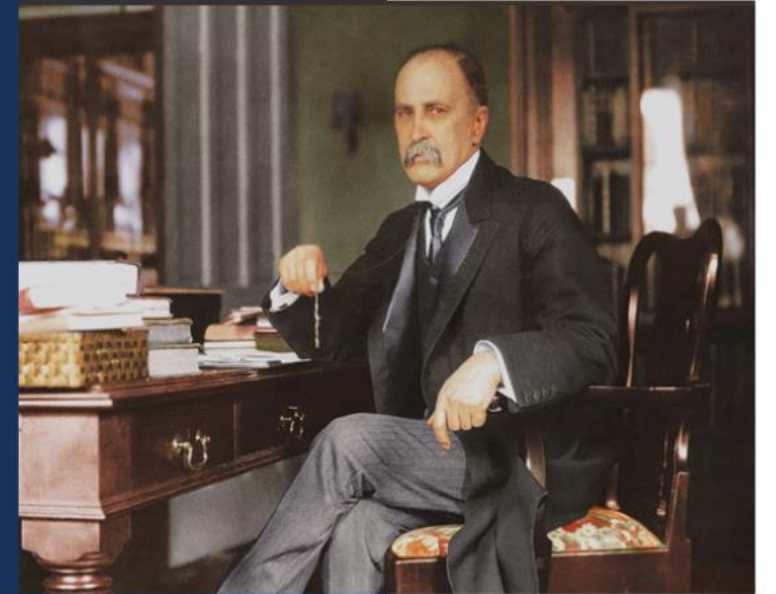

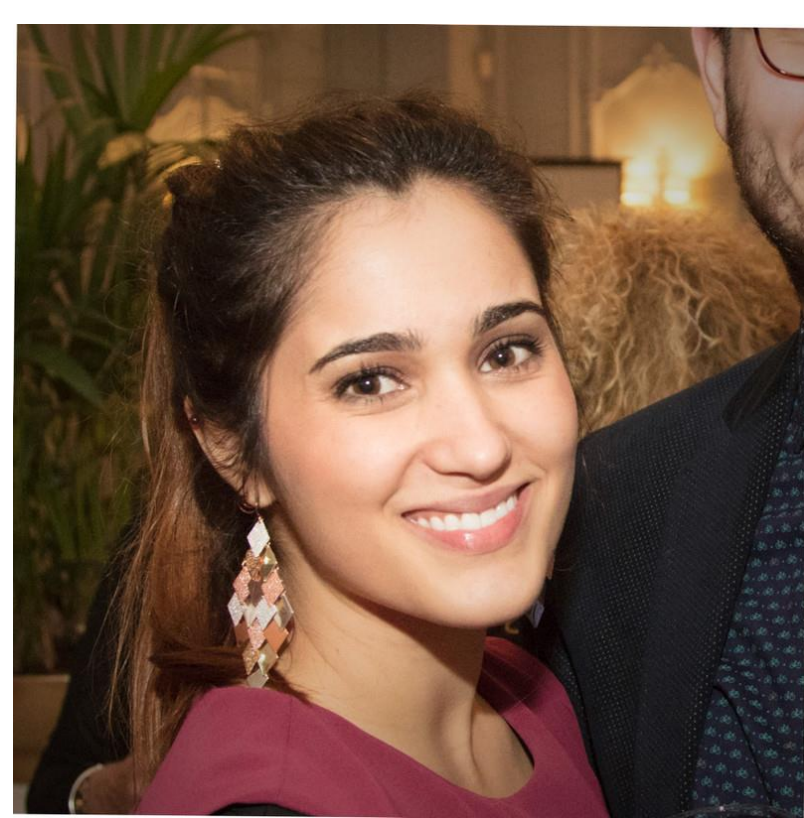
