Judith Jaeger is a neuropsychologist with more than 35 years' experience in clinical and experimental neuropsychology and psychopathology. Previously she was Vice President for Clinical Trials at Cogstate, Inc. and Director of Clinical Development at AstraZeneca Pharmaceuticals where she served as company-wide cognition and psychometrics expert. These industry positions followed a distinguished academic career as an NIH funded research clinician and educator. Since forming CognitionMetrics, she has advised numerous pharmaceutical companies on early phase and experimental medicine projects as well as pivotal and late phase clinical programs in Alzheimer and other dementias, neurodegenerative and neurodevelopmental diseases, ADHD, schizophrenia, bipolar disorder, major depression and oncology.
