Bio:

I am a psychiatrist and researcher based at the VA Puget Sound in Seattle, and the Denise L Tabbutt Professor of Trauma and Brain Health at the University of Washington. I run interventional clinical trials in PTSD, as well as mechanism-focused observational trials in PTSD and other trauma-related disorders. Areas of emphasis include the integration of clinically-accessible biomarkers measured at baseline to predict treatment response and the use of aggregated n-of-1 clinical trial designs (multiple crossover designs) to address population heterogeneity and precision medicine aims in clinical trials. My work also focuses on physiologic biomarkers of catecholamine dysregulation following trauma, including measures of autonomic and sleep measures, and the mechanisms by which these biomarkers relate to symptoms expression. I also see patients in the VA PTSD Outpatient Clinic and on the comprehensive DBT team.
