Seth Hopkins, PhD, is a thought leader in advancing measurement in drug development trials for psychiatric indications. He is currently heading up Translational Medicine at Otsuka. Prior to his role at Otsuka, he led Translational Medicine and Early Development at Sumitomo Pharma America, where in positions of increasing responsibility, he led and advanced ulotaront, non-racemic amisulpride, and dasotraline from their discovery through to regulatory submissions. His published research focuses on methods to improve the clinical development of breakthrough treatments for psychiatric disorders. In 2024, Seth received the Lewis A. Opler Prize for his advances in measurement, which have helped accelerate the development of new treatments or cures for CNS disorders. He completed his postdoctoral training at the University of California, San Francisco, and holds a PhD in biophysics from the University of Pennsylvania
