- We reviewed the most salient threats to the validity of international clinical trials and outcomes
  - The group expressed the opinion that clinician-rated outcomes (CRO) were a top priority over cognitive and patient reported outcomes (PRO).
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  - meaningful narratives for abuse potential assessment
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- Conduct a literature to establish the current published guidance and gaps on translating CRO
- Apply the Wild (1995) criteria for translating PRO to CRO measures of common interest
- Continue work group collaboration via email to identify the scales of common interest and to establish best practices to guide the translation of CRO measures
